

Andrew Carnie: into the forest, projection work

A selection of works that examine my interest in trees, dendritic form, networks and mycelium, with a move towards projection and video works that start in around 1990 and continue to this day. They are large scale pieces

The work is often time-based in nature, involving slide projection using dissolve systems or video projection onto complex screen configurations. In a darkened space layered images appear and disappear on suspended screens, the developing display absorbing the viewer into an expanded sense of space and time through the slowly unfolding narratives that evolve before and around them. This work has been exhibited widely from the Daejeon Museum in South Korea to Exit Art in New York and more recently in the exhibition Brain(s) at the CCCB, Barcelona and Espacio Fundacion Telefonica, Madrid










Complex Brain: Spreading Arbour, 2004, 2 x video channels, voile screen, installation, size variable








Blue Matter 2019 (installation view, gif animation), 28 min four channel HD video, on black voile screen, size variable






Video set-up for **Here There and Everywhere,** 2020, 4 channel HD Video, dimensions variable










A Tale of Two, 2019, USB programmable fans, sensors, black voile screen and 5 min repeating HD video, size




Storm to Calm: Rockall 2019, 5 meteorological balloons, fans and sensors, size variable







As Things Come to Pass, (Winter Tree), 2019, still from 2 channel HD video, 2 projectors, 6m x 2.5m x 5m, continuous loop


Here There and Everywhere, 2020 4 channel HD Video, dimensions variable



Video set-up for **Here There and Everywhere,** 2020, 4 channel HD Video, dimensions variable


